Recommendation

Port staff recommends that the Port Director:

1. Approve the proposed CPI-U rate increase to items in the Port of Stockton's General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5
2. Authorize Port staff to submit the proposed change in Tariffs to the California Association of Port Authorities to secure the CPI-U rate increase approval
3. Upon confirmation of California Association of Port Authorities approval, authorize Port Staff to amend Port of Stockton General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect rate changes with the effective date of July 1, 2020
