Pursuant to notice duly given, the Public Hearing of the Port of Stockton was held on September 25, 2019, in Room 18 of the Port of Stockton Administration Building located at 2201 West Washington Street in Stockton, California.

The Public Hearing was called to order by Port Director Aschieris at 9:00 a.m. Port Director Aschieris presided and Melanie Rodriguez, Secretary, acted as Secretary for the meeting.

### CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED LANGUAGE UPDATES TO ITEMS IN THE PORT OF STOCKTON GENERAL TARIFF NO. 1 AND TERMINAL TARIFF NO. 5

Director of Maritime Operations Katindoy provided an executive summary of this agenda item. Mr. Katindoy's presentation included the following:

The Port conducts an annual review of the language in the General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5. The authority and responsibility for approving changes to the Port of Stockton's Tariffs has been delegated to the Port Director by the Board of Port Commissioners. The following language updates were proposed for General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5:

### General Tariff No. 1

Item	Subject	Proposed Language Update/Change
93	Emergency Standby	New item establishes the responsibility of a Tenant during an emergency situation: 1. Point of Contact 2. Tenant representative responsibility 3. Failure to perform
1416	Railcar Storage	Remove the “UP.com” reference and add “SteelRoads.com” in its place. This is related to the language referring to the Union Pacific Railroad website; however, the correct website is the Steel Roads website.

### Terminal Tariff No. 5

Item	Subject	Proposed Language Update/Change
285	Basis for Computing Dockage Charges	Remove sub-item (3) defining the Length Overall (LOA) rounding methodology. Rounding is no longer needed as a result of an updated structure of the Dockage rate table.
605	Taking, Releasing and Shifting Lines	Update Note 2 to include “Long Lines” Remove Note 3 as it is no longer needed due to rehabilitation of Dock 12/13.
900	Terminal Security Fee	Update note to read, “Ocean carriers calling at port wharves under a marine terminal services agreement may be subject to a discounted rate as per the negotiated marine terminal agreement.”

The legally required Notice of Public Hearing appeared in “The Record” on September 13, 2019. It was also posted to the Port’s website. As of the date of the Public Hearing no public comments were received.

If the proposed tariff changes are approved by the Port Director, then Port staff will submit the proposed changes to the tariffs to the California Association of Port Authorities (CAPA) to secure the approval of the proposed language updates through the process established by CAPA and the Federal Maritime Commission. After receiving CAPA approval Port staff will implement the proposed changes to Port of Stockton’s General Tariff No 1 and Terminal Tariff No 5, for an effective date of November 1 2019.

Port Staff recommends that the Port Director: approve the proposed language updates to items in the Port of Stockton’s Tariff; authorize Port staff to submit the proposed changes in the Tariffs to the California Association of Port Authorities; and, upon confirmation of CAPA’s approval, authorize Port Staff to amend the Port of Stockton General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect the proposed language updates with the effective date of November 1, 2019.

Port Director Aschieris acknowledged that there were no requests from the public to address him on this matter.

Port Director Aschieris approved the proposed language updates to items in the Port of Stockton's Tariff; he authorized Port staff to submit the proposed changes in the Tariffs to the California Association of Port Authorities (CAPA) to secure approval; and, upon confirmation of CAPA's approval, he authorized Port Staff to amend the Port of Stockton General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect the proposed language updates with the effective date of November 1, 2019.
