Recommendation

Port staff recommends that the Port Director:

1. Approve the proposed CPI-U adjustments, labor rate adjustments, and language amendments to items in the Port of Stockton's General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5
2. Authorize Port staff to submit the proposed Tariff CPI-U adjustments, labor rate adjustments, and language amendments to the California Association of Port Authorities to secure approval
3. Upon confirmation of California Association of Port Authorities approval, authorize Port staff to amend Port of Stockton General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect changes with the effective date of July 10, 2021
