Language Amendments

Additionally, Port of Stockton plans for the following language adjustments to certain items in General Tariff #1 and Terminal Tariff #5 in order to clarify items or to remove items that no longer reflect Port operations/services and/or are applicable.

General Tariff No. 1

- Item 1417, Ship's Pilot – Detention Time: Cancel

Terminal Tariff No. 5

- Item 200, Service and Facilities Charges – Definition Of: Language added/removed for clarity
- Item 335, Application of Wharfage Rates: Language added/removed for clarity

Justification:

- Rate adjustments ensure the District keeps current with laborcosts, supporting operational expenses and District policies. Language amendments ensure that the Port's tariff schedule remains current/applicable with its business practices.



Recommendation

Port staff recommends that the Port Director:

Staff recommends that the Port Director approve the proposal to implement rate and language adjustments in the Port of Stockton's General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5. and authorize staff to work with the California Association of Port Authorities (CAPA) to secure rate adjustments and language amendments approval. Upon confirmation of CAPA's approval, authorize staff to amend Port of Stockton General Tariff No. 1 and Terminal Tariff No. 5 to reflect rate adjustments and language amendments with the effective date of July 1, 2026.
